This is an introductory course for learning to program with animation. Students create animation projects using Alice, a software package for creating animation in small virtual worlds using 3D models in Pixar and Disney animation style. The emphasis of this course is hands-on labs, with some lecture/presentation. Although designed for the novice programmer, the course may also be taken by more advanced students.
